
NowDocs Signature Blocks

The following signature blocks have been developed to provide our clients guidelines for signature recording.

1. Sign in both boxes. The most satisfactory copy will be used. If you want a specific signature box, please indicate.
2. Signature copy should be as close as possible to the desired size. Confining your signature to the box will enhance the appearance of the check. If you desire this signature to be scaled, please indicate.
3. Please sign with a roller ball or fountain to provide us with the optimum media for digitizing you signature(s).
4. If type, logo, or title are combined with signature(s), illustrate its approximate position on the "example" illustrated below. Should stand alone logo(s) be required, please supply camera-ready art for best results.

For one line signatures

A rectangular box with a thin border, intended for a single line of a signature.



A rectangular box with a thin border, identical to box A, intended for a single line of a signature.


For two line signatures

A rectangular box divided into two horizontal sections by a thin line, intended for two lines of a signature.


B



A rectangular box divided into two horizontal sections by a thin line, identical to box A, intended for two lines of a signature.


For three line signatures


A rectangular box divided into three horizontal sections by two thin lines, identical to box A, intended for three lines of a signature.
